For DOCK120 Series USB Chargers (electrical rating: DC 5V 4.2A)

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING - To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury to persons:

- 1. Use the unit for indoor only.
- 2. Do not use extension cord(s) that is not supplied by National Lighting to connect the unit(s).
- 3. Do not try to open the unit for any reason.

MOUNTING


SURFACE-MOUNT

- 1. Place the charger on the desired surface and use two screws (included) to fasten it onto the wood surface.
- 2. Connect the input cord to the input jack in the back of the DOCK120.

3. DOCK120 can be daisy-chained up to two units per wiring branch. Use the other jack in the back of the DOCK120 to connect two units together.

USING THIS USB CHARGER

- 1. Plug the power adapter to nearest wall outlet.
- 2. Connect the USB type A connector from the mobile device to the charger. The charging power per port cannot exceed DC 5V, 2.1A (approx. 10W).
- 3. The green indicator lights up when charging.
